## LA TÊTE MOMIFIÉE 024584 /TOI MOKO 31

Thank you for your email dated 20 February 2010 indicating the Musée d'ethnographie Genève wishes an update about La tête momifiée 024584 /Toi moko 31, which was repatriated to the Museum of New Zealand Te Papa Tongarewa (Te Papa) in 1992.

In respect to your request, I am pleased to indicate the Toi moko (La tête momifiée 024584 /Toi moko 31) is housed in Te Papa's Wāhl Tapu (a sacred repository only for human remains). The Wāhi Tapu is climate controlled with strict access conditions.

Furthermore the New Zealand government recognised Te Papa's contribution to the repatriation of Māori ancestral remains by mandating Te Papa's <u>Karanga Aotearoa Repatriation Programme</u> to undertake repatriation work on behalf of New Zealand. This is also supported by Māori.

Since 2003 Te Papa has repatriated 186 kōiwi tangata (Māori ancestral remains) back to New Zealand, with 82 kōiwi tangata (Māori ancestral remains) returned to their place of origin in New Zealand by Te Papa and its predecessor the National Museum.
